

What type of Domain Name should I apply for?

The diagram below summarises the requirements for each second-level domain category.

com.sg

This domain is for commercial entities. Applicants must be a company or business in good standing registered with the Registry of Companies and Businesses (RCB), Trade Development Board (TDB) or professional bodies such as the Law Society in Singapore.

net.sg

This domain is for network providers. Applicants must be an Internet Service Provider or other entity registered with the Telecommunication Authority of Singapore (TAS).

org.sg

This domain is for non-profit and non-government organisations Applicants must be a society or other non-profit organisation registered with the Registry of Societies (ROS) in Singapore.

gov.sg

This domain is for all government organisations. Applicants must be part of the Singapore Government. The Ministry of Information and the Arts (MITA) maintains the authoritative list of government organisations.

edu.sg

This domain is for educational institutions. Applicants must be an educational institution registered with the Ministry of Education, Singapore.

SGNIC Profile

SGNIC was established as a not-for-profit organisation to administer the .sg domain name space.

Officially known as Singapore Network Information Centre (SGNIC) Pte Ltd, SGNIC is a wholly owned subsidiary of the National Computer Board (NCB) with its Board of Directors comprising representatives from various organisations involved with the provision of Internet services in Singapore. These organisations are the NCB, the Telecommunication Authority of Singapore (TAS), and the three Internet access service providers - Cyberway, Pacific Internet, and Singnet.

Incorporated in June 1997, SGNIC operates on the principle of non-profit-making. As such, SGNIC fees are structured on the basis of cost-recovery and are channelled into providing better Internet registry and information services. Surplus funds, if any, are used for SGNIC operations including organising regular DNS Seminars, for the benefit of the Internet community.

SGNIC is committed to providing Internet registry and information services in an efficient, effective and responsible manner, so as to ensure the smooth running of the Internet in Singapore.
